ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements.	£1200
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (within a 30 miles radius of our premises) into our care	£250
Care of the deceased person (-*-) before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will be kept at Holmhill, Station Road, Keith. AB55 5DR or at a branch of your choosing.	£300
Providing a quality coffin— made from an oak veneer (cheaper basic coffin available)	£600
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director. *By law a fee is listed but we do not charge for service.	£1*
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (within 30 miles of our premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£550
UNATTENDED FUNERAL Mourners do not attend the place of burial or cremation. You may choose to hold a memorial service, ceremony or gathering for the deceased at a later date.

Cremation (Funeral directors charges, including, coffin, crematorium charges, medical fees & transportation)	£1650

(1) This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
(2) In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
